BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the resignation of Wilbert Naranjo from the Whiteriver Police Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it expresses its appreciation to Officer Naranjo for the performance of his duties as a Police Officer and Adult Tribal Prosecutor during his tenure as an employee of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 5,1993</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (s) (t) (u) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
