

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution 08-93-215 directed that a proposed amendment to the Tribal Government Code be posted in each district in accordance with the requirements of the Tribal Constitution for a minimum ten days period prior to final action; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the proposed amendment was inadvertently posted with superfluous language that may have resulted in a misunderstanding by persons wishing to comment about said proposed amendment; and

WHEREAS, in order to rectify the situation, the Tribal Council concludes that the proposed amendment should be reposted in the form attached hereto as originally directed to be posted pursuant to resolution 08-93-215.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to post in each district for a minimum of ten days as required by the Tribal Constitution, the proposed amendment to the Government Code, in the form attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the posting of the proposed amendment is for public comment purposes only and that said amendment shall not become effective after ten days but shall only become effective if and when there is a final vote by the Tribal Council to enact and adopt the amendment as written.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that public comments on the proposed amendments to the Government Code should be directed to the Office of the Tribal Chairman, to the Offices of members of the Tribal Council, the Tribal Legal Department and the Office of the Tribal Council Secretary.

The foregoing resolution was on August 18, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of four for three against and one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (h) (i) (q) (r) (s) (t) (u) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
