


**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has recently accepted the resignation of Wilbert Naranjo as Adult Tribal Prosecutor and as a police officer with the Whiteriver Police Department; and
- WHEREAS,** there is a need to appoint on an interim basis a prosecutor to represent the White Mountain Apache Tribe in criminal cases; and
- WHEREAS,** by previous resolution the Tribal Council placed the adult and juvenile prosecutor under the supervision of the White Mountain Apache Legal Department; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Attorney recommends that pending hiring of a full time adult prosecutor that Joseph Hessinger, Attorney at Law, licenses by the State of Arizona, who has previously served as the Tribe's prosecutor, be retained as a part time employee without any fringe benefits pending final selection of a full time adult prosecutor; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Attorney advises the Tribal Council that preference in the recruitment and selection shall be given to Native American attorneys licensed to practice in the State of Arizona for the full time adult prosecutor's position.
- BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and appoints Joseph Hessinger as part time prosecutor for the adult court pursuant to terms to be negotiated by the Tribal Attorney's office with final approval by the Tribal Chairman pending selection of a full time adult prosecutor.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by Tribal Council that the part time employment of Joseph Hessinger as prosecutor for the Tribe shall not include any employee benefits.


Resolution No. 08-93-234

The foregoing resolution was on August 30, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (b) (i) (k) (t) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
