## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- the Tribal Council concludes that a staff picnic during WHEREAS, business hours for Tribal Council members and staff members from the Business, Executive and Human Resource Buildings is in the best interest of the Tribe and provides an opportunity for the Tribal Council and Business, Executive, and Human Resource staff to meet and confer so as to enhance cooperation during the business year; and
- the Tribal Council approves expenses and mandates WHEREAS, attendance to this event, members of the Tribal Council, Business, Executive, Human Resources, Purchasing, Community Services, Land Offices and Tribal Forestry staff.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates September 23, 1993 as the official staff picnic, approving expenses and mandates attendance for the Tribal Council and for Business, Executive, Human Resource staff, Purchasing, Community Services, Land Offices and Tribal Forestry staff.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs every department supervisor or manager to post this resolution in their respective offices.

The foregoing resolution was on September 09, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
