RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- Tribal member, Kasey Velasquez, has come before the WHEREAS. Tribal Council this date and reported that he had received a degree and is inquiring about employment within the Tribe; and
- Tribal Council having reviewed Mr. Velasquez WHEREAS. educational accomplishments and experience concludes that he should be recommended for a position with the Tribe; and
- the Tribal Council recommends to the Director of Social WHEREAS, Service that his application with the Tribal Social Service Department be considered; and
- the Social Service Director advised the Tribal Council WHEREAS, that her program is funded by 638 federal funds and that she will abide by the Tribal Council's recommendation but that necessary background checks must be accomplished in accordance with federal regulations.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recommends to Tribal Social Services Director that tribal member Kasey Velasquez be considered for a position with the Tribal Social Service Department that Mr. Velasquez has applied for in accordance with contract requirements of the program.

The foregoing resolution was on October 13, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
