RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mrs. Patricia James-Tolino, whose birthdate is January 29, 1958 has requested tribal enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- whereas, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Mrs. Tolino's enrollment application and supporting documents; and
- whereas, the Tribal Enrollment Committee finds Mrs. Tolino eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum of one-half White Mountain Apache through her father, Willie James; and
- WHEREAS, Patricia James-Tolino has been a permanent resident of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation since 1983; and
- WHEREAS, Patricia James-Tolino has provided a conditional Relinquishment for enrollment from the San Carlos Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby grants Patricia James-Tolino
 membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe based on
 the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on October 20, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
