RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, District II Councilmember Kino Kane, on behalf of residents of Carrizo and Cedar Creek communities request that their communities Land Claim Funds be utilized so that they may sponsor Halloween activities; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council is advised that Carrizo Community is requesting \$500.00 and Cedar Creek Community is requesting \$300.00 from their communities Land Claim funds; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council is advised that Carrizo and Cedar Creek Land Claim funds have sufficient monies to grant this request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized use of \$500.00 from Carrizo Land Claim funds and \$300.00 from Cedar Creek Land Claim funds, so they may sponsor Halloween activities for their communities.

The foregoing resolution was on October 23, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
