## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member, Patsy Nosie has come before the Tribal Council on behalf of her brother, Buster Nosie and mother, Julia Mosby, with a request that they be placed on the HIP Housing Priority List; and
- whereas, Ms. Nosie advises that her brother, Buster Nosie suffered a stroke and is presently handicapped and in a nursing home; and her mother, Julia Mosby is an elderly person; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council concludes that Buster Nosie and his mother, Julia Mosby do meet the criteria to be placed on the HIP Housing priority list.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that Mr. Buster Nosie and his mother, Julia Mosby, be placed on the HIP Housing Priority List.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>November 03, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
