RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member Serina Skidmore, a widowed woman, has been homeless for fifteen years and is in great need of adequate shelter; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Skidmore does not have any children and therefore does not qualify for HUD rentals because of her lack of dependents; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that there is a need for emergency shelter for Ms. Skidmore.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that tribal housing be provided to Serina Skidmore on an emergency basis before the onset of winter.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>November 03, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
