RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the completion of the Apache Cultural Education Facility will require the existing building be devoted to that purpose; and
- WHEREAS, the appraised value of the building, land and site
 improvements is \$390,000; and
- WHEREAS, the ICDBG program will not fund furniture and equipment;
 and
- WHEREAS, the estimated costs of furnishing and equipping the new facility is \$50,000.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the land and partially completed building commonly identified as the New Cultural Education Facility Center at the west end of Fort Apache be committed for the purpose of the ICDBG program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$50,000be committed to the furnishing and equipping of the completed Apache Cultural Education Facility.

The foregoing resolution was on November 04, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) (h) (i) (j) (k) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
