**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the Elderly Home in Cibecue has ben shut down by the Program Director without notice to the community in a way which does not reflect cultural respect to elders in the community; and

WHEREAS, former residents of the Elderly Home have been transferred; and

WHEREAS, Cibecue Tribal Councilmember Judy DeHose objects to the abandonment of the Elderly Home in Cibecue without appropriate notice to the community and affected families, employees and elder residents; and

WHEREAS, she requests that the Elderly Home be immediately reactivated and that elderly and employed persons be transferred back to the Home; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Elderly Home in Cibecue should be immediately reopened, that consenting elderly persons should be transferred back to the Home as necessary and that employees be transferred to the Home to the extent necessary to serve elderly residents in the Home.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Elderly Program Director to immediately reactive the Cibecue Elderly Program service and the Elderly Home including but not limited to recruiting elderly persons for the Home, transferring elderly persons to the Home with their consent and transferring or reassigning former Cibecue Elderly Home Employees back to the Home.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs the Program Director to consult with the community leaders and Council representatives from the district in which Elderly Homes are located prior to shutting the Homes down in the future so as to honor the cultural respect due elders and the community.


