

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** tribal members, Dennis & Josephine (Thomas) Dazen, have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of May 27-29, 1994; and

**WHEREAS,** Roy, Sr. & Lorinda (Nastiva) Tenijieth, have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and

**WHEREAS,** arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Fort Apache Crossing.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Dennis & Josephine (Thomas) Dazen, Sponsors, and Roy, Sr. & Lorinda (Nastiva) Tenijieth, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of May 27-29, 1994 at Fort Apache Crossing.

The foregoing resolution was on November 04, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
