RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Economic Development Administration has provided support for a number of economic projects for the White Mountain Apache Tribe over the years; and
- whereas, the EDA has funded a planning grant for the Tribe in the past and has requested the Tribe to submit an application for the continuation of planning support; and
- whereas, the beneficial effects of the Tribe EDA relationship has contributed to the economic base of the Tribe; and
- whereas, the need for jobs and income is the most pressing facing
 the Tribe and the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the submission of a grant application to EDA in the amount of \$34,000 for the continued support of the Tribal Planning Office.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Chairman Ronnie Lupe is authorized to execute any and all documents associated with the grant and grant application.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 08, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (j), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
