## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Billy Duryea, Jr. appeared before the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council on December 15, 1993 in order to request that a land assignment be converted to his name; and
- WHEREAS, Billy Duryea, Jr. presented the Tribal Council with a White Mountain Apache Land Assignment Relinquishment Form ("Form") by which Billy Duryea, Sr. conveyed his interest in the lands described within the form; and
- whereas, the Land Board has approved Billy Duryea, Sr.'s conveyance of all of his interest in the land described, to Billy Duryea, Jr.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that all of Billy Duryea, Sr.'s interest in the land described in the document shall be assigned to Billy Duryea, Jr.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 15, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i) and (m) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
