## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Executive Building was destroyed by fire on or about December 7, 1993; and
- WHEREAS, whereas the tribal council members' offices, including those of the Chairman and Vice-chairman, were located in that structure; and
- WHEREAS, whereas the council members, including the Chairman and Vice-chairman, must, and have, continued to carry out their duties; and
- WHEREAS, whereas significant personal effects of the council members were destroyed in the fire.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Moutain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes an emergency budget amendment by adding \$5,000 for travel expenses for the Vice-chairman, by adding \$5,000 for office expenses for the office of the Vice-chairman, and by adding \$1,000 for each council member, including the Chairman and the Vice-chairman, to immediately reimburse those council members for articles lost or destroyed by the fire.

The forgoing resolution was on <u>December 15, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, including Article IV Sections 1 (a), (h), (i), (k), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
