

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe as the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is vitally concerned about the health and welfare of its tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for a program, that temporarily provides emergency food for White Mountain Apache families in crisis; that provides a referral and tracking system to assist these families to become self-sufficient; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been notified of the availability of competitive grant applications for hunger relief programs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that a proposal for an emergency food program should be submitted to Share Our Strength (SOS), and that the Tribal Health Authority, Tribal Inter-Agency Coordinating Committee, and Tribal food Distribution should work together to implement the program if it is awarded to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Health Authority, Tribal Food Distribution Program and IACC to prepare the emergency food distribution proposal for submission to the Share Our Strength Organization.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Chairman Ronnie Lupe, or in his absence Vice Chairman Lafe Althaa, are hereby authorized and delegated to review and sign the application and any required grant forms in order to complete the grant application.

The foregoing resolution was on December 15, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section (a), (b), (i), and (j) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
