

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has met and discussed the issue of utilizing land claims funds for the purpose of financing Christmas or holiday celebrations during the month of December; and

WHEREAS, the use of such funds for these purposes would be beneficial to the various reservation communities.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the use of land claims funds to sponsor Christmas parties as follows:

- District I - \$1,000 for the community of Cibecue;
- District II - \$1,500 for the community of Carrizo,
\$1,000 for the community of Cedar Creek,
\$ 800 for the community of Forestdale;
- District III - \$1,000 for the community of Seven Mile,
\$1,000 for the community of East Fork;
- District IV - \$1,000 for each of the following
communities: McNary, North Fork, Whiteriver
and Canyon Day.

The foregoing resolution was on December 15, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
