## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission pursuant to the Tribal Election Code is authorized to certify those candidates who have met those qualifications for Tribal Council set forth in Article XII, Section 1 of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission have submitted their certification to the Tribal Council for review and acceptance of qualified candidates to the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the Election Commissions Certification of Candidates and concludes that the document should be accepted as presented.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the Certification of Candidates which is attached and hereby incorporated by reference.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these individuals shall have their names placed on the 1994 Primary Election Ballot of the White Mountain Apache Tribe as eligible candidates.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 30, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>three</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article XII, Section 1, Article VI, Section 8, Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
