RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation is concerned about the employment of its people in various tribal projects; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, under extraordinary circumstances, been approached to assist in the reinstatement of Marion Jimson, Rachel Willie, and Rose Gass to their positions with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority; and
- WHEREAS, there appearing good cause for the Tribal Council to favorably act upon that request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby directs the Executive Director of
 the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to reinstate
 the above named individuals to positions of employment
 with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that this resolution is in no way to serve as a precedent for future action on tribal employment matters and that future employment concerns are to be resolved through routine employment grievance or other administrative procedures.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 30, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
