RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Canyon Day Community President, Nolan Clay, has come before the Tribal Council and renewed his request for a convenience store and gas station on behalf of the Canyon Day Community; and
- whereas, the Council representatives for the East Fork and North Fork Communities has also requested on behalf of those communities that consideration be given to those communities for construction of mini-stores and gas stations; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council, after discussion of environmental concerns, concludes that Mr. Gerald Alsenay, General Manager for Apache Enterprises, should be directed to develop a budget for mini-market/gas stations for the communities of Canyon Day, North Fork and East Fork for consideration by the Tribal Council for fiscal year 1994/1995.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Mr. Gerald Alsenay, General Manager for White Mountain Apache Enterprise, to develop a budget for construction of mini-market/gas stations for the communities of Canyon Day, North Fork and East Fork for fiscal year 1994/1995.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 05, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h) and (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
