## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member, Isabelle Mason has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request that she be placed on the HIP priority list; and
- whereas, she advises the Council that three (3) years ago she was
   placed on the list but to date has not received a home;
   and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Mason presently resides in an old shack that is
   falling apart and is inadequate to provide shelter for
   her family; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that she should be placed on a priority list for HIP housing immediately.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Bureau of Indian Affairs to place Isabelle Mason on the revised HIP housing list and that she be assigned a priority to receive a house due to her present living circumstances.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 05, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i), (k), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
