## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by previous resolution, the Tribal Council directed that
  amendments to the Elderly and Adult Protection Ordinance
  be posted for public comment; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed Ordinance has been posted for more than ten (10) days as required by the Tribal Constitution and no public comments have been received in opposition thereto; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the amendments to the Elderly and Adult Protection Ordinance should be adopted and enacted by the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts the attached amendments to the Elderly and Adult Protection Ordinance, to be effective immediately.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 05, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (q), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
