RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Councilmember Randall Massey, Jr. advises the Tribal Council that there is a great need for bus shelters on the Reservation to protect children in cold and inclement weather; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Massey requests that the Tribal Council direct the Tribal Planning Department to apply for BIA or State funds for construction of bus shelters throughout the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Planning Department to apply for Bureau of Indian Affairs or State funds for bus shelters for children throughout the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 05, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i) and (j) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
