

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Billie Jean Bones and her mother have come before the Tribal Council with a request for Council approval to use \$1,550.72 of District IV Land Claims Funds for her to attend the National Unity Youth Council in Rhode Island; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with her request and acknowledges the petitions she has submitted from District IV residents.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the use of \$1,550.72 of District IV Land Claims Funds for Billie Jean Bones to attend the National Unity Youth Council in Rhode Island.

The foregoing resolution was on February 24, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


