RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, prior Resolution No. 04-93-068 directed the Cattle Associations to provide the names of their elected officers, to designate stockmen and prepare a cattle inventory by owner and brand for filing with the General Livestock Association and that the General Livestock Office be directed to provide a report of each association to the Tribal Council immediately thereafter; and
- approved a proposal for training of the WHEREAS, prior Resolution No. 04-93-128 elected officers of each livestock association and the General Livestock Office by E.A.R.C. for the eventual purpose of adopting updated formal goals and by-laws by the livestock associations and the General Livestock Associations; and
- WHEREAS, said resolutions adopted a deadline for the election of association officers and stockmen by July 1, 1993 and for livestock inventory by ownership and brand for each livestock association by September 15, 1993; and
- WHEREAS, an extension of time is requested until September 1994 and the Tribal Council concurs in said request.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends the deadlines for Resolution No. 04-93-068 and Resolution No. 06-93-128 to September 30, 1994.

The foregoing resolution was on February 10, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (r), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
