RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has questions regarding the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) PH 90-692 which would transfer operation and maintenance responsibilities from the Indian Health Service to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the Cibecue Lagoon system; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that acceptance and approval of the MOA should be tabled until IHS can appear before the Council and respond to inquiries about the project.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby tables any action on MOA PH 90-692 until such time as an IHS representative can appear before the Tribal Council and respond to Council questions regarding the agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 24, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
