RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Rose Walker has come before the Tribal Council and advised the Council that her brother is very ill and is undergoing tests in Phoenix to determine the nature of his illness, which to date is unknown; and
- WHEREAS, Rose Walker requests that a tribal vehicle and modest financial assistance be provided to her to enable her to travel to Phoenix and to stay with her brother during his time of need while tests are being conducted regarding his illness.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to provide a tribal vehicle and financial assistance for Rose Walker so that she may visit her brother at the hospital in Phoenix during the time he is undergoing medical tests.

The foregoing resolution was on February 24, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
