RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, tribal member and employee, Beverly Aday, has come before the Tribal Council with a request that 161 hours of her sick leave be transferred into a like number of hours of annual leave because she utilized all of her annual leave to attend to her mother who had heart surgery; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Beverly Aday's request should be granted and that her request is justified.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Human Resource Division to transfer and convert 161 hours of sick leave earned by tribal employee, Beverly Aday to 161 hours of annual leave.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 24, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (h), (i) and (s) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
