## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Council Resolution No. 07-90-146 said "it is necessary that a forest Management Plan be prepared every 10 years for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and an inventory is needed every 10 years for computation of tree growth, annual allowable cut and other considerations in the Forest Management Plan, and the previous measurement of Continuous Forest Inventory plots was made in 1984 and the next measurement needs to be performed in 1994,"; and
- WHEREAS, Continuous Forest Inventory measurement field work is scheduled to begin September 1, 1994, and conclude April 1, 1996; and
- WHEREAS, it is highly desirable that the Tribal Forestry Department conduct the field measurement that will provide 20 seasonal jobs totalling 14.4 man years; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry Department is capable of conducting the field measurement under a \$317,144 reimbursement cooperative agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affair's Branch of Forestry.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves execution of a Cooperative Agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for remeasurement of the Continuous Forest Inventory plots on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation from September 1, 1994 to April 1, 1996.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman or the Vice Chairman in the Chairman's absence, or their designee, it hereby authorized to negotiate and sign the aforedescribed cooperative agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (j), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
