

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, residents of the town of McNary have come before the Tribal Council this date with complaints of sub-standard housing and the need of heavy equipment, such as dump trucks and front-end loaders, to assist the community in its proposed clean-up day; and

WHEREAS, several members of the community described to the Tribal Council housing needs and the needs of the community generally; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the request for assistance from the McNary community are well taken, and that the town of McNary should receive better housing as well as assistance for its clean-up efforts.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Housing Authority begin planning for a subdivision to be constructed in the town of McNary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that FATCO, Apache Materials and FATCO Home Center provide paint, dump trucks, and front-end loaders to assist the residents of McNary in their clean-up efforts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs the Whiteriver Police Department and the Bureau of Indian Affairs Law Enforcement to remove non-member trespassers and to investigate undersirables and report back to the Tribal Council and the Office of the Tribal Chairman the feasibility of establishing a substation for the Whiteriver Police Department in McNary.

The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
