WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested by District I Councilmember Judy DeHose that it grant approval for the use of the gravel pit above the Beach's residence, located in Cibecue for community roads; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in the request.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves use of the gravel pit above the Beach residence in Cibecue for the purpose of providing gravel for community roads and improvements.

The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
