- WHEREAS, Anthony and Virginia (Dillon) Cromwell have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and
- WHEREAS, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Seven Mile.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Randy and Maria (Adley) Classay, Sponsors, and Anthony and Virginia (Dillon) Cromwell, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of August 12-14, 1994 at Seven Mile.

The foregoing resolution was on April 13, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
