RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council adopted Resolution No. 06-93-139 on June 16, 1993 directing that Orita Altaha not work for the same enterprise or department as Varnell Gatewood, Sr. until such time as an investigation is completed by law enforcement agencies regarding the murder of Jimmy Altaha; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council directed that the Tribal Chairman take whatever steps were necessary to temporarily transfer Orita Altaha from employment with the ID Herd Office pending the outcome of the criminal investigation of the death of the late Jimmy Altaha; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to reaffirm said resolution in its entirety.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reaffirms Resolution No. 06-93-139.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it directs that Orita Altaha be temporarily transferred from employment with the ID Herd Office pending outcome of the criminal investigation of the death of the late Jimmy Altaha and that a letter be sent to her from the office of the Tribal Chairman directing said transfer.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>May 11, 1994</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
