## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Education Board of Directors, Director and Scholarship Coordinator advises that many tribal members miss the opportunity for a higher education because of the low income requirement for tribal scholarships; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that educational assistance should not be based on a family's income but should be available to any tribal member desiring a higher education; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Education Board of Directors, Director and Scholarship Coordinator request that the Tribal Council direct a waiver of the low-income requirement for scholarships other than those funded by 638 contract.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Education Department to waive the low-income requirement for tribally funded non-638 contract scholarships for tribal members desiring a higher education.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and one against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
