**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that there are significant shortcomings inherent in the current Personnel Policy; and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution of those shortcomings may be affected by a review and reformation of the Personnel Policy; and


**WHEREAS**, those persons within the Tribal Business Office are in the best position to raise and address issues relating to the Personnel Policy.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Business Office to form a committee to address the Personnel Policy.

The foregoing resolution was on June 01, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h) and (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
