RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is aware that a new Superintendent of Education is to be appointed for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has in the past worked with Henry Jacobs while he served in such capacity with this Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe's relationship with Mr. Jacobs was well received by the Tribal Council, and was conducive in the building of a progressive reservation school system.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby supports the appointment of Henry Jacobs to the position of Bureau of Indian Affairs Superintendent of Education for the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 01, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
