RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the federal government, through the Resource Recovery and Conservation Act, has mandated the establishment of sanitary landfills that comply with the requirements of the law; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received a grant from the HUD Community Development Block Grant program for the establishment of a solid waste landfill in the amount of \$1.1 million; and
- WHEREAS, an effective landfill operation requires the establishment of a solid waste collection system which is estimated to cost approximately \$950,000; and
- WHEREAS, Farmers Home Administration has indicated that they have the potential for funding the equipment and other related costs of the solid waste collection system.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves submission of a pre-application to the Farmers Home Administration for a combination loan/grant from solid waste collection system equipment costs, estimated at \$950,000 of which a combination of grant and loan funds for 75% is estimated to be covered by the grant.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 01, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h) and (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
