RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS,	housing conditions on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation could be substantially improved with rehabilitation to standard conditions for a number of owner occupied homes; and
WHEREAS,	the Indian HOME program has announced that funds are competitively available for addressing housing needs on Reservations; and
WHEREAS,	the program requires matching funds to be competitive; and
WHEREAS,	Farmers Home Administration has approved at least \$2.7 million in loan funds for water system upgrades that can be used as match; and
WHEREAS,	IHS funds, while not counted for match purposes, will be used in conjunction with the HOME program; and
WHEREAS,	the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority has the expertise and willingness to administer the program for the tribe.
BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves that a grant application be prepared for the HOME funds with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority as the administering agent and Farmers Home loan funds be used as a match.	
The foregoing resolution was on June 01, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 () of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
