RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Erv Kulosa was very effective in the Tribe's Forestry Department which represents an important component of the Tribe's exercise of our self-determination over our natural resources and the retirement of Mr. Erv Kulosa has created a vacancy in the key position of Director; and
- WHEREAS, the Assistant Director, Mr. Dennis Biere, was recruited and hired as the potential replacement for Mr. Kulosa and possesses the skills and experience in forestry management that are required for the position of Director of the Tribal Forestry Department; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Biere has received excellent evaluations from his supervisor, Mr. Kulosa and was highly recommended for the position of Director by Mr. Kulosa; and
- WHEREAS, the continued effective operation of the Tribal Forestry Department is dependent on the availability of skilled management direction from a person with Mr. Biere's qualifications.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. Dennis Biere to the position of the Director of the Tribal Forestry Department.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 01</u>, <u>1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (f), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
