RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there are numerous homes within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation owned by Tribal Members, and many of those homes are in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, funding for such repair is available through the Comp. Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, some homeowners who have paid off their homes have been unable to obtain such Comp. Grant Assistance.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to assist such homeowners obtain this Comp. Grant Assistance for home repairs.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 01, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
