RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Yoshbel Thompson, an enrolled Tribal member and resident of District III has come to her Tribal representative with signed petitions seeking financial assistance to allow her to attend the United National Indian Tribal Youth Conference to be held in Tampa, Florida from June 24 to June 28, 1994; and
- WHEREAS, Yoshbel has demonstrated her leadership ability through her active involvement in numerous community events; and
- WHEREAS, by her attendance at the conference, Yoshbel will gain valuable experience and will return to her community with new skills and knowledge; and
- WHEREAS, funding for her trip is available through the District III Land Claims Fund.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that \$674.00 be withdrawn from the District III Land Claims Fund and awarded to Yoshbel Thompson to pay for her expenses in attending the United National Indian Tribal Youth Conference in Tampa, Florida.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 16, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (g), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
