RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is recognized by the United States of America as the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council gave its consent to the Farmers Home Administration to build approximately thirty (30) homes on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation many years ago; and
- WHEREAS, the Farmers Home Administration has sold some of the underlying mortgages to these homes to other financial institutions through foreclosure actions or assignments; and
- WHEREAS, the Farmers Home Administration has also initiated foreclosure procedures on some of these homes; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has utilized the services of the Bureau of Indian Affairs to prepare an appraisal of the fair market value for the sale of the foreclosed homes so that the White Mountain Apache Tribe can evaluate and make a determination regarding purchases of said homes from the Farmers Home Administration pursuant to a first right of refusal policy established with the FmHA; and
- WHEREAS, tribal members Euclan and Patricia (Pusher) Walker have a FmHA home which is now in foreclosure and approval is required by the Tribal Council to initiate a BIA appraisal of said home.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process for appraisal of the fair market value of the Euclan and Patricia (Pusher) Walker FmHA home for the benefit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 21, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
