RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has this date discussed and reviewed the Central Tribe budget for FY94/95 with the Tribal Treasurer and Tribal Controller; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the Central Tribe budget should be approved as agreed and discussed in Tribal Council session; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, as part of the FY 94/95 budget, concludes that due to extraordinary expense, the temporary security guards which were hired after the December 8, 1993 Executive Building fire, should be discontinued with a ten day notice of termination.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the Central Tribe budget for FY 94/95 as presented and modified this date by the Tribal Council.
- BEIT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby discontinues the temporary employment of security guards effective ten days from the date of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 21</u>, <u>1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
