

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, Tribal Member Davina Parker has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request that prior Resolution 04-94-90 which authorized her to purchase a home located in Hondah homesite A-73 be amended to state that she be authorized to purchase a home in Hondah homesite A-63 instead; and


**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council grants her request.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby hereby authorizes Davina Parker to purchase the home located in Hondah homesite A-63.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that its previous authorization for Davina Parker to purchase a home in Hondah homesite A-73 is hereby vacated.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that all other provisions in Resolution 04-94-90 pertaining to Davina Parker's purchase of a home at Hondah homesites shall remain in full force and effect, except that the Council's authorization shall apply to Ms. Parkers's purchase of a home in Hondah homesite A-63 rather than in Hondah homesite A-73.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (e), (h), (i), (m), (n), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
