RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Doreen Way has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request that she be assigned a rental unit by the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority as soon as one is available; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Way explains to the Council that she is currently employed by the Whiteriver Police Department, has two children and that no emergency housing is available for her; and
- WHEREAS, on at least one occasion, Ms. Way has been homeless and has been forced to sleep outside with her young child without adequate shelter; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority should be directed to assign a rental unit to Ms. Way as soon as one becomes available.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to assign a rental unit to Doreen Way as soon as one is available.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 13, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>10</u> for and <u>0</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (m), (n), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
