**WHEREAS,** tribal members, Juna (Caddo) Tessay & Mary Jane (Tessay) Patterson have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of October 8-9, 1994; and


**WHEREAS,** Anthony & Sarafina Henry, have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and

**WHEREAS,** arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at Cibecue, Arizona.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Juna (Caddo) Tessay & Mary Jane (Tessay) Patterson, Sponsors, and Anthony & Sarafina Henry, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of October 8-9, 1994 at Cibecue, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
