WHEREAS, Candidate Wilson requests Tribal Council endorsement of her candidacy; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, after discussion, concludes that Ms. Wilson should be so endorsed.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby endorses and supports the candidacy of Dottie Morris Wilson for Navajo County Clerk of the Superior Court.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 03, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
