


**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Councilmember Margaret Baha-Walker, has requested Tribal Council funding to repair and fund ten one-room homes in her district because of very poor housing conditions that exist there; and


WHEREAS, after considerable discussion with the Tribal Council, the Council concludes that the Tribal Planning Department should seek funding for housing repairs reservation-wide.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Finance Committee, working together with the Tribal Planning Department, to seek funding to repair homes in all communities throughout the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on August 04, 1994, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (j), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
