RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that the Head Start Parenting Program under Inter Governmental Agreement ("IGA") with the State of Arizona expired on June 30, 1994; and
- **WHEREAS**, the proposed IGA for the program has been submitted to the appropriate state agency for approval; and
- whereas, pending State agency review and final funding approval of the Head Start IGA for FY1994/95 it is necessary that the Tribal Council authorize by resolution a continuation of funding for this much needed program until the IGA is approved.
- BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes funding of the Tribal Head Start Parent Training Program until the program's approved contract is received.
- **BEIT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that upon approval of the IGA, the Tribe shall be reimbursed.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 04, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (j), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
