## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Game and Fish Code has provisions regulating the operation of logging trucks on the Reservation, which have been deleted from the proposed revisions of the Game and Fish Code; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Health and Safety Code, Charter 12, regulates the operation of motor vehicles on the Reservation, and therefore, is the appropriate Chapter for regulations governing logging trucks.

BEIT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Council Secretary to post the proposed amendments to the Tribal Health and Safety Code in each District for ten days as required by the Constitution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 04, 1994</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
